OFFICE MEMORANDUM

**Subject: Instructions issued amending various provisions relating to e-Visa.**

The undersigned is directed to say that recently Ministry of Home Affairs has issued various instructions amending the following provisions related to e-Visa:

(I) Manohar International Airport, Mopa Goa has been designated as an authorized ICP for entry of persons holding e-Visa. Now persons holding e-Visa will be allowed to enter into India only through designated international airports namely, (1) Delhi (2) Mumbai (3) Chennai (4) Kolkata (5) Thiruvananthpuram (6) Bengaluru (7) Hyderabad (8) Cochin (9) Goa (10) Ahmedabad (11) Amritsar (12) Gaya (13) Jaipur (14) Lucknow (15) Trichy (16) Varanasi (17) Calicut (18) Mangalore (19) Pune (20) Nagpur (21) Coimbatore (22) Bagdogra (23) Guwahati (24) Chandigarh (25) Visakhapatnam (26) Madurai (27) Bhubaneswar (28) Port Blair (29) Kannur and (30) Mopa.

(II) It has been decided to include Morocco in the list of countries whose nationals are eligible for grant of e-Visa. The facility of e-Visa is now available to the nationals of 167 countries for entry through 30 aforesaid designated airports.

(III) It has introduced a new Visa regime i.e. Ayush (AY) Visa for foreigners visiting India for treatment under Ayush Systems/ Indian systems of medicine and also to provide e-Ayush visa and e-Ayush Attendant visa to such foreigners. It, is therefore, requested to kindly disseminate the aforesaid information for a better facilitation of tourists.
