**Subject: Registration of buses- reg.**

Sir/Madam,

I am directed to refer to the representations received from the All India Motor Transport Congress (AIMTC) and Delhi Transport Department (DTD) regarding the list of 130 and 8 buses respectively which are pending for registration.

2. As per clause 7 (c) of Rule 125C of Central Motor Vehicles Rules, 1989 (CMVR), the aforementioned buses are required to be registered as per AIS 153 which came into effect from 01.09.2025. Further, Section 110(3) of the Motor Vehicles Act, 1988 (MV Act) empowers Central Government and State Government to exempt any motor vehicle to grant exemption from the applicability of such provision.

3. Accordingly, the proposals from AIMTC and DTD were examined by this Ministry and the Competent Authority has accorded approval to complete the registration process of these buses wherein, before 01.09.2025:

(a) Body building initiated and completed; applied for permanent registration irrespective of tax payment.

(b) Body building initiated but not completed;

(c) Body building not initiated.

4. The buses under (a) mentioned above may be allowed to complete the registration process under section 110(3) of the MV Act, 1988.

5. The buses under categories (b) and (c) mentioned in para 3 above, shall undergo type testing by the Testing agencies notified under Rule 126 of the CMVRs, 1989. Only after the type testing has been completed, the buses should be accepted for registration.

6. Further, it is requested to take appropriate action under section 110(3) of MV Act, 1988 to facilitate completion of the registration process.

7. This issues with approval of the Competent Authority.
